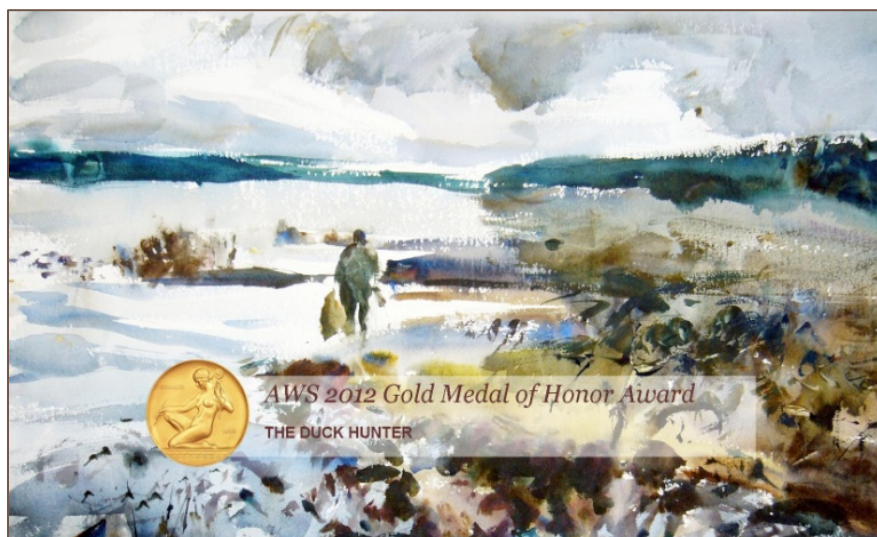

He will also show how to mount the Masa paper for a permanent presentation, with or without glass. Suggested materials: *MASA Paper*
