

It requires an understanding of specific design concepts in order to free one's mind. Each day, Eric will focus on one of these principles. He will show how to construct a beautiful painting in one sitting, and free creative thinking from cumbersome theories of color and composition. There will be time for individual instruction in a relaxed atmosphere.



All levels of expertise and individual style will benefit from Eric's broad depth of experience. Eric currently teaches several different kinds of workshops: *Wiegardt's Painterly Watercolors*, *Watercolor Plein Air Workshop, Wiegardt's Painterly Acrylics*. He also offers his Painterly Watercolors workshop online via Zoom, as well as a Mentoring Class and a Paint-Along.

Eric will demonstrate how to create a three-dimensional batik appearance for both abstraction and representational subject matter. He will also show how to mount the Masa paper for a permanent presentation, with or without glass. Suggested materials: *MASA Paper*
